

RECOMMENDED GROUP STUDIES

At Christ Church we desire to resource our groups and leaders with the best materials possible.

With the amount to resources available today, choosing one that is right for your group can easily become overwhelming. Is it biblically sound? It is gospel-centered? Will it be worth your group's time?

Below, we have compiled several group resources that we believe to be biblically sound, centered on the gospel and absolutely worth your group's time.

Our recommendation would be to start with a study from our **Gospel-Fluency** section. Taking the time to discuss the gospel and it's implications on the Christian life is at the very core of a groups unity, identity and missional purpose.

Next, we would suggest choosing a resource from the *Biblical Theology* section. Once your group has a gospel foundation, it is vital to begin building a biblical framework. Biblical Theology is nothing more than seeking to understand the Bible in it's completeness: 66 books declaring 1 story of God's redemptive work through the person of Jesus.

Finally, selecting a study from the *Everyday Discipleship* section is a great way to focus intently on an area of the Christian life that is of interest to your group as a whole. The summer is often a great time to choose a study from this section. Some groups may decide to study something together, or split up the men and women to work through an individual study.

Each of the resources mentioned will require some monetary investment from the members of your group. Most of the resources require minimal preparation for the group leader and many have discussion questions for the group to consider together.

It is our hope that these recommendations would help foster a deep and lasting gospel culture within your groups as you consider together what it means to demonstrate and declare the good news of Christ to one another, the community, and the world.
